the who have installed the light plants.

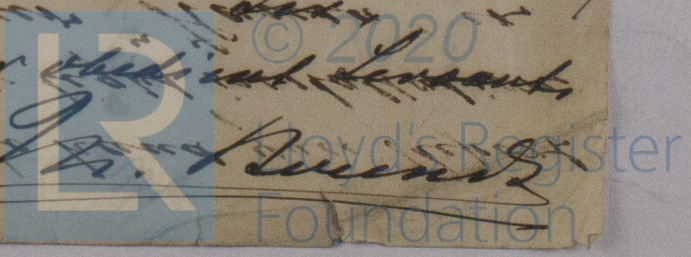
With regard to the Fees and Expenses
