Other items:- Vessel placed in drydock, bottoms cleaned and coated, rudder mainpiece renewed, repairs effected to rudder etc., steering gear, bilge keels and bulwarks, and minor repairs carried out.

The 2nd S.S. No. 2 due 6.33 completed has also been held and following repairs done due to wear and tear:- repairs and renewals effected to bunkers, hatches chain pipes and minor repairs carried out.

The bridge deck plate, as above, has been renewed and the Poop deck stringer plate doubled.

It is submitted the vessel is worthy to remain as classed, with record of Survey 2-34 and notation of Sd No 2-34 without special conditions, as recommended.
