on this date.



The whole of the 2nd special survey No.3 has been carried out concurrently with the freeboard survey and the vessel will be recommended to remain as classed with fresh record of survey 5-36 and notation for s.s. 2nd No.3-5,36.

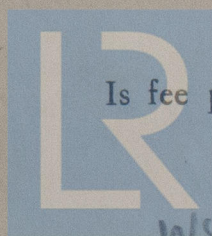
The original freeboard certificates have been transmitted to the Dutch Authorities for extension by them until the end of the year of grace allowed for the next special survey, ultimo May, 1941.
