I have to acquaint you that the Convention freeboard survey of the s.s. "GASTELU" has recently been completed at Antwerp, and I accordingly send herewith a copy of the Convention freeboard certificate issued in respect of this ship for transmission to the Spanish Authorities, who should be informed that the condition of assignment for ordinary cargo freeboards has been complied with as follows:-

Steel wire lifelines with rigging screws have been provided in the fore and after wells.

At the same time I have to inform you that timber deck cargo freeboards have not been marked on the ship's sides at this time.
