With reference to Newcastle Report No. 89004 on the Freeboard of the s.s. "ANGLO AUSTRALIAN", and to your Assignment Letter of 13th August last, I have to report :-

- (1) The tarpaulins of Nos. 4 & 5 hatchways on the freeboard deck have been renewed.
- (2) The hinged steel covers over the fidley gratings have been satisfactorily repaired.
- (3) Wood plugs have been provided for all air pipes.
