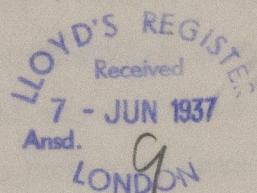

Your favour of 4th inst. to hand.

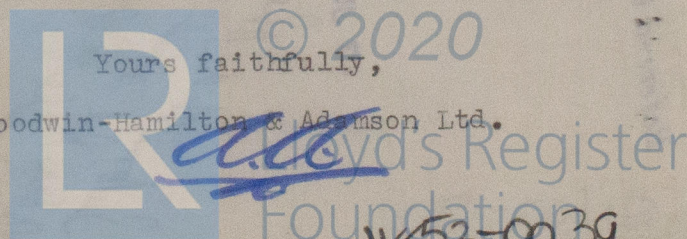
We must apologise for the mistake made in sending you samples of the Fresh Water as supplied to s.s. instead of the water drawn from boilers that had been in use since Calcutta.
