Dear Sirs,

I duly received your letter of the 31st ultimo respecting the Steamer "MANIPUR", and may say that the samples of water referred to therein have now been received at this Office. These, however, are labelled "Samples of fresh water for boilers, supplied in Calcutta and Port Said".

You will doubtless appreciate that if, as is inferred, this water is taken from the fresh water tanks and not from the boilers themselves, it is not suitable for the purpose in view. What is desired is a sample (two quarts) of water taken from the boilers, and representative of the condition of the boiler water as it is actually in use, and containing any chemicals which may be employed in the usual boiler treatment, and I shall be glad if you will kindly request the Chief Engineer to forward the desired samples as soon as possible.
