We understand that a discussion took place between Messrs. Esplen's representative and your surveyors at your London office, regarding a modification to the thrust block seating, after the original plans had been submitted to you, and we are informed that it was agreed to considerably stiffen the thrust block seating extension aft of the bulkhead.

Messrs. Esplen have requested us to forward to you amended copies shewing the additional stiffening of the thrust block seat, and we have now pleasure in enclosing up-to-date plans of same.
