Steamers "GLITRA", "VILLE DE DUNKERQUE" and "KUHRS".

Owners Messrs. Douglas & Ramsey, Glasgow.

"GLITRA". Laid up at Swansea under an undertaking furnished by Messrs. Douglas & Ramsey in June last. Second Special Survey No.3 became due in 5,35.


"VILLE DE DUNKERQUE". Built in 1918 in Japan, 3190 tons, disclassed (Three Dots).

"KUHRS". Built in 1901 in Holland, 3160 tons, never classed with this Society.

The attached letter from Glasgow has been received in regard to the two latter vessels.

As regards the "GLITRA", a memorandum of an interview with Mr. Douglas at this Office is also attached.

The cases are submitted for the consideration of the Committee, but in the event of any modified form of survey being considered, *for the vessel which is classed* it is suggested that such examination should take the form of a complete *examination of all the parts &* opening up as for Special Survey, with a modification of repairs recommended to safeguard the efficiency of the vessel for any extension of operation desired.
