With reference to the classification in the Society's Register Book of the steamer "GLITRA", I beg to acquaint you that the Committee have today had under their consideration the case of this vessel in view of the fact that the year of grace allowed for the 2nd Special Survey No.3 has now expired. It is understood that the vessel is laid up at Swansea, and in such cases I would explain that it is the Committee's usual practice to require Owners to furnish an undertaking to carry out all overdue surveys before the vessel again goes into commission.
