Dear Sir,

With reference to your letter of the 12th. instant addressed to the Rouen Surveyor regarding the grounding of the steamer "GLITRA", at Rouen, a copy of which was attached to the Rouen Report No.1518, this was not mentioned by the Master when the vessel was under repair in this Port.

After receiving the Report on the 24th. instant, when visiting the vessel to examine the completed repairs to the Main Mast, the grounding was mentioned by me. The Master stated that he was satisfied no damage had been sustained by the vessel, and that he had been informed it was quite usual for vessels to ground when discharging at that port.
