I have to enclose herewith a memorandum setting out the freeboards which have been assigned under the new International Loadline Convention in the case of the steamer "GLITRA" for ordinary and timberdeck cargoes and it is understood that the Captain expects to be able to arrange for the freeboards to be marked upon the vessel's sides while she is Montreal.

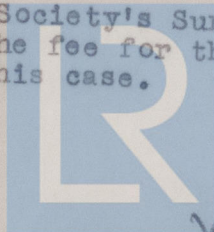
