


Dear Sir,

International Convention Freeboards.

With reference to your letter of 30th inst. enclosing particulars of Freeboard Assignment, we beg to state we have been in communication with the Captain this morning but are informed by him that as the vessel is now under the Coal Spouts loading and expected to sail tomorrow morning, there appears to be no opportunity for the new markings to be placed upon the sides at this time. He states that the vessel is proceeding to Canada, expected to return to the U.K. with a cargo of grain, and he proposes, in the circumstances, to defer the freeboard marking until her return to this country.
