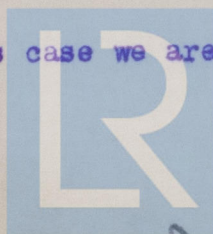

We have to inform you that all the requirements of the Convention have now been complied with, and we enclose herewith a supplementary report to report No. 18129 giving the further particulars required as per your letter of the 14th ultimo. On the last page of this report is shown the requirements which have now been complied with, with view to the carriage of timber deck cargoes.

The Owners' Representative informs us that the vessel leaves this port to-night for Dunston on the Tyne, and that she will leave the Tyne on the morning of the 2nd April, and in view thereof the owners will be obliged if the freeboard assignment may be forwarded direct to the Surveyors at Newcastle and arrangements made for the new freeboard markings being verified before the vessel leaves at port.

We may say that in this case we are not advising the Surveyors at Newcastle.
