Dear Sirs,

I beg to acquaint you that from information received from the Society's Surveyors at Leith, relative to the steamer "GLITRA", it would appear that, subject to the requirements of the International Loadline Convention being complied with, the Summer freeboard could be reduced by about  $1\frac{1}{4}$  inches for ordinary cargoes, and by about  $6\frac{1}{4}$  inches when carrying timber deck cargoes, when the Convention is ratified.
