H. With reference to the 2nd Special Survey No.3 which became due at the end of June 1932 on the steamer "MOERDIJK", which vessel has been laid up at Rotterdam under the usual undertaking, I have to acquaint you that in view of the satisfactory general examination now held at that port the Committee have agreed to this vessel proceeding to an Italian port with a non-perishable cargo to be broken up.

In the circumstances I shall be glad if you will give the case attention and advise me immediately the work of demolition is commenced.

I may say that according to the Shipping Papers that vessel has been sold to S.A. Cantiere di Portovenere of Spezia.


