CLASSIFICATION OF VESSELS LAID UP.

With reference to the list of vessels laid up under an undertaking, I am directed to inform you for the confidential information of the Committee of Lloyd's that the case of the steamer "MCERDIJK" (No. 51240 in Register Book) has to-day been under the consideration of the Sub-Committee of Classification, together with a request that the vessel may be allowed to proceed with a non-perisable cargo to Italy, to be broken up, and that this request has been agreed to subject to a satisfactory general examination, in accordance with approved instructions, being made of the vessel by the Society's Surveyors at Rotterdam before she proceeds on this voyage.

A notation to this effect is accordingly being made at the foot of the list in this office of vessels laid up under an undertaking.
