Dear Sirs,

With reference to your First Entry Report No.11354a on the Steel Screw Steamer "WOERDIJK" (ex "DENDERAH"), and to your remarks on the back of the report regarding the draft of this vessel, I have to inform you that as intimated in my letter of the 2th July last the scantlings of the ship were found to be deficient from the Rule requirements for the shelter deck class, and, in view of the deficiency, the General Committee decided that the vessel might be classed LOCAL conditional upon the restricted draft of 26'3" (extreme) being marked on the vessel's sides.
