The 2nd S.S.No.1 became due 6,31.

The vessel requires to be further examined in dry dock on account of grounding.

The vessel has been laid up in the Tyne since about April 1931 and the usual undertaking has been furnished.

In February last the Owners advised this Office that the vessel had been sold to Messrs. South Stockton Shipbreaking Co., Stockton on Tees, for breaking up purposes.

In reply to enquiry the Newcastle Surveyors^{state} that the vessel is reported in the local press to have left the Tyne for Stockton, in tow, and that the local agents have informed them that the vessel has been sold to the Stockton Shipbreaking Co. for breaking up.

It is submitted the notation "To be broken up" be recorded in the Register Book.
