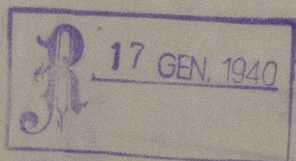

On the 10th instant we replied to  
your enquiry of the 8th inst as follow  
which appears to have crossed your  
present enquiry:-

"We have been in touch with the Owner  
who states that the double bottoms  
under Engines & Boilers were examined  
and tested at Civitavecchia in April  
1939, also at same time the Inner Bot-  
tom and Bilges in Engine and Boiler  
Spaces were examined. This has been  
verified from R.I. but apparently  
these items were done by a Non-  
Exclusive Surveyor of the Registro  
Italiano.

The Owners inform us however that  
the vessel is expected at an Italian  
Port in about one month's time, and  
he will do his best to have these  
items dealt with by the Society's  
Surveyors.

The R.I. have also the repairs to  
tunnel sheathing and W.T. doors  
indicators outstanding so efforts  
will be made to have these points  
also dealt with at the same time."
