I am in receipt of Mr. Herbert's letter of the 18th instant enclosing one received from Messrs. The Antwerp Engineering Company, together with a plan showing a proposed modification to the girder at Nos. 2 and 3 hatchways of the steamers "BELGIER" and "NERVIER", and with regard thereto I have to state that the alternative arrangement of hatch side girders as indicated on the plan will be approved. The suggested alternative arrangement with a rider plate fitted over a part of the girder length is not, however, considered satisfactory.

The proposal to employ 9 x 3½ x .44" in lieu of 8½ x 3 x .50" bulb angles will be approved.

The plans of the "BELGIER" and "NERVIER" forwarded by you for reference are returned herewith, together with the above mentioned plan.
