during alterations,


and that I have transmitted to the Committee of Lloyd's Register of Shipping, London, a Report, stating that all repairs recommended by me have been completed to my satisfaction, and that I have Recommended that she be continued as classed * 100 A1 in the Society's Register Book, without fresh record survey, subject to the vessel being placed in dry dock for

permanent repairs on her return to Antwerp from her proposed voyage to East & South Africa, via Suez Canal, the notation of S.S.No.2 to be deferred till the survey is completed, being fit to carry dry and perishable Cargoes.

The Special Survey No.2 became due in December 1926 and should be completed before the expiration, in November 1927, of the year of grace allowed by the Rules.
