We thank you for your favour of the 31st ult., and
the contents.

The information we have via the Salvage Association
to the present is that this vessel is lying on an even keel
a shelf of rocks off Dakar. At the moment dry cargo is
being discharged into coasting vessels, and the total amount
cargo which is expected to be salvaged will be about 3400 tons.
When this is out, the special officer of the Salvage Association
will then decide if salvage of the vessel will be possible, and
think that until his report comes forward it would not be
advisable to expunge the vessel's name from the Register Book,
there is always the possibility of her being salvaged, and
probably put into a good and seaworthy condition again.

If we have any further news to report, we shall, of
course, communicate with you.
