Dear Mr. Roffey,

On the 26th November last an official letter was sent to you with regard to the electric lighting installation of the U.S. "BRAEMORE". It was found on trial that the engine was not working satisfactorily, and the report was sent to the Dublin Office in November 1921 in view of a statement that the defect would be made good at that port. In October 1922 it was stated that the vessel was laid up and that arrangements had been made for the matter to receive attention before the vessel put to sea.

As we do not appear to have had a reply to the letter above mentioned, I should be glad if you would write stating how the matter stands and whether the report on the electric lighting is still in your possession.
