E. With reference to the s.s. "BRAEMORE", No. 15120 in the Register Book, I have to acquaint you that the electric lighting installation of this vessel was fitted at Hull, but after a short trial it was found that the engine was running hot and the governor not working.

The vessel then proceeded to Dublin and the report on the installation was forwarded to the Society's Surveyor at your port on the 1st November, 1921. This report does not appear to have been returned to this Office and I shall be glad therefore if you will state how the case now stands.


For your information I enclose a copy of a letter dated 26th October, 1921, from the Surveyors at Hull regarding this installation.
