Dear Sir,

In reply to the Secretary's letter of the 22nd instant regarding the S.S. "BRAEMORE", No. 15120 in the Register Book, I beg to inform you that the report on the electric lighting installation of this vessel was still in the Society's office at Dublin when I left that port in October, 1922. At that time the vessel was laid up and no opportunity had been afforded of completing the survey on the electric lighting installation, but arrangements had been made with Mr. Roffey, the Owners' Superintendent, for the case to have attention before the vessel was again put into service.
