E With reference to the S.S. "BRAEMORE", No. 15120 in the Register Book, I have to acquaint you that the electric lighting installation of this vessel was fitted at Hull, but after a short trial it was found that the engine was running hot and the governor not working.

It was stated that the vessel was to proceed to Dublin, and the report was sent to the Surveyor at that port on 1st November 1921 for his information.

The report does not appear to have been returned to this Office, and I shall be obliged if Mr. Forster, who was stationed at Dublin at that time will be so good as to furnish any remarks he may be able to offer in regard to the matter.
