

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 31st ultimo respecting the steamer "TEREPOOL", and note that this vessel is under contract for sale to Italy and that delivery has to be made either to Genoa, Savona or Spezia.

Your remarks regarding the condition of sale are duly noted, and if a certificate for the maintenance of her class for the voyage to Italy is required, it will be necessary for a general examination to be carried out by the Society's Surveyors, with a view to a report being furnished on her general condition, and if the Surveyors are satisfied that she is in a fit condition to proceed, an interim certificate can be issued for the voyage in question.

As you are aware, the year of grace allowed for the completion of the Third Special Survey No.1 has now expired. I shall therefore be glad if you will let me know when and at what port the survey, if desired, can be carried out, in order that the necessary instructions may be issued to the Society's Surveyors in the matter.

I would also remind you that the freeboard

certificate in this case expired on the 31st ultimo, and will require to be extended to cover the proposed voyage, and this can be done subject to the general examination being satisfactory.

It is also noted from your letter that the steamer "TWICKENHAM" has been sold under similar conditions, and in this case I would remind you that the freeboard expired on the 31st May last, so that a similar examination to that referred to in the case of the "TEESPOOL" will require to be carried out in this case also, and the freeboard marking verified.

I await a further communication from you in this case also.
