CLASSIFICATION OF VESSELS LAID UP.

With reference to my letter of the 1st March last respecting the steamer "TWICKENHAM" (No. 86821 in the Register Book), I think it well to acquaint you that, in view of a subsequent proposal submitted by the Owners, the case has today received the consideration of the Committee, together with ^{an} ~~a~~ report received from the Society's Surveyors at Newcastle-on-Tyne, and the Committee have agreed to the vessel proceeding with a cargo of coals to Italy, where, after discharge, she will be broken up.

The footnote against the vessel's name in the list in this Office of vessels laid up under an undertaking is being amended accordingly.
