Remarks of the Chief Ship Surveyor are desired on this case for the consideration of the Classing Committee.

The class is subject to indented tank top plating being dealt with at the first convenient opportunity and shell plates A2 and B2, port side and B2, starboard side, all aft, E.W.repairs 5,39, being specially examined at the next drydocking.

The Cardiff Surveyors now report the vessel examined afloat and on account of damage through striking quay, 2 shell plates and some deck plating etc. renewed, repairs to shell plating, framing, deck and minor repairs carried out.

The indented tank top^{plating} as above, examined and found efficient.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed without record of survey, subject as above.

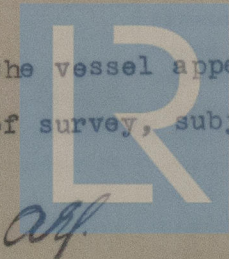
