I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 30th ultimo with reference to the entry in the Society's Register Book of the particulars of your Steamers "MANIN" and "DANDOLO", and in reply to explain that at the time the current edition of the Register Book was being printed, the reports on these vessels had not reached this Office so that the usual entry of 100A1 "Class Contemplated" was inserted, indicating that the Steamers were under the Society's survey with a view to classification.


