With reference to the 2nd Special Survey No.2 which became due at the end of April 1931 on the steamer "BENGUELA", which vessel is now the property of Captain Francesco Jaccaro of Brindisi, I have to acquaint you that in view of the satisfactory nature of the general examination held by the London Surveyors last month the Committee agreed to this vessel proceeding to Italy to be broken up.

It would appear from the Shipping Papers that the vessel arrived at Savona on the 18th instant, and in the circumstances I shall be glad if you will give the case attention and advise me immediately the work of demolition is commenced.
