Dear Sirs,


S. I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 23rd instant respecting the steamer "JOHANNA", from which I note that you propose to complete the Boiler Survey of this vessel within two months, and having submitted the case to the Committee at their meeting to-day, I have to say that they are agreeable to this arrangement.

I may add that the Committee have also had before them a report from the Rotterdam Surveyors from which it appears that on account of damage sustained through the propeller striking a quay wall the screwshaft has been examined and one propeller blade found slightly damaged, which will be renewed at the first convenient opportunity.
