CHARTERING DEPT.

Dear Sirs,

S. I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 15th instant respecting the steamer "ANDROMEDA" ex "HUNTRESS" now lying at Rotterdam, from which the Committee note that the opening and cleaning up of this vessel for the overdue 2nd Special Survey No.1 has been suspended awaiting developments.

With regard thereto I am directed to remind you of the undertaking given in your letter of the 27th October last that you would carry out the requirements of the 2nd Special Survey No.1 on the steamer's arrival in Europe, and as you are aware in view of this the repairs which were carried out at that time were confined to those actually necessary to enable the vessel to make the voyage you desired from Port Natal.

The preliminary report which has now been received from the Society's Surveyors at Rotterdam on the steamer's condition is such that the Committee must ask you to be good enough to give a categorical reply as to whether you have decided to proceed with the survey, as otherwise they will have no option but to deal with her class at once.
