S. Reverting to my letter of yesterday's date respecting the Steamer "HUNTRESS", I have to inform you that I am now in receipt of a cablegram from the Society's Surveyor at Durban, reading as follows, viz:-

HUNTRESS IN VIEW OF DETERIORATION FOUND GENERALLY UPPER DECK TWEEN DECKS COLLISION BULKHEADS DEEP TANK BULKHEADS TANK TOP AND INTERNAL SURFACES OF SHELL CONSIDER VESSEL IS UNSATISFACTORY FOR DRY AND PERISHABLE CARGO OR FULL DEADWRIGHT SOUTH AFRICAN GOVERNMENT SURVEYORS CONCUR.
