In addresses consisting of a name followed by a word "CARE," (a) or some equivalent expression must be inserted after the name of the person to whom the telegram is to be sent.

Time is saved and greater accuracy secured by the Public handing in their telegrams direct to the Company's Stations as above, where receipts are given for the amount charged.
