With reference to my report No. 3386 on the steamer "ANDREAS K.", and my letter of the 16th of June last, I beg to inform you that this vessel has now been sold for breaking up purposes. The buyer duly approached me with a view to grant him a certificate of seaworthiness to enable the vessel to be towed, by two tug-boats, to Italy, with a cargo of about 5000 tons of scrap iron or manganese, after carrying out all necessary temporary repairs, for this voyage, to my recommendations and satisfaction.
