Gentlemen:

With reference to your letter of August 3 regarding the s.s. "Soengei Gerong" we are now able to advise you that we have sold this vessel to Shanghai to be scrapped.

It is our intention to send the "Soengei Gerong" with a cargo of white products to Hong Kong, after which she will proceed to Shanghai. The cargo for Hong Kong will not be required until the end of January, so that the vessel will not sail from Palembang prior to January 15, 1933. The certificate of seaworthiness expires on December 31, 1932, but the Head of the Dutch Shipping Inspection at Rotterdam has advised us that there are no objections against an extension of this certificate for the duration of the intended voyage, provided that your office agrees to this.

We hope that you will be able to grant us an extension for the above mentioned period.
