I duly received your letter of the 18th instant respecting the steamer "SOENGBI GERONG" from which I note that the Owners have applied for a Certificate from the Shipping Inspection up to the end of October, 1932, and that you desire to have confirmation of the fact that the Society's Surveyor at Sourabaya recently had this vessel under survey at that port.

I accordingly have pleasure in stating that this vessel was generally examined by the Society's Surveyor at Sourabaya between the 1st and 7th December, 1931 and on receipt of this report the Committee agreed to the Owners' proposal to carry out the Second Special Survey No.2 within the year of grace allowed by the Rules for the completion of this survey, this period expiring at the end of October, 1932.

The vessel's class, viz:- 100A1, Carrying Petroleum in Bulk, has therefore been continued by the Committee on this understanding.
