Dear Sirs,

s/s "FLORA" Reported to have sunk at Sagres after stranding  
5 miles North St. Vincent on the 27th. August 1934.

We beg to own receipt of your favour of the 12th. inst. with  
reference to the casualty reported to have occurred in the case of the  
above named vessel and note that in accordance with the usual practice,  
the question of inserting a record of the circumstances against the  
vessel's name in the Register Book will be put under the Committee's  
consideration at an early meeting.

Further we note that in the event of such a record being made  
the vessel's character would be expunged from the Register Book.

We also learn that if we are aware of any circumstances which  
may render it desirable that the Committee should defer taking the steps  
above described to communicate with you by post.

Having nothing to add to the communication made, we leave  
for your Committee to take the usual steps in such a case.
