M I duly received your letter of the 5th instant enclosing test certificates in respect of an anchor and chain cables supplied for the S.S. M.4 ("UNION"), building by the Ateliers & Chantiers de Saint Nazaire, Penhoet, and in reply thereto I have to state that the weight of kedge anchor as supplied will be approved in this instance.
