Reverting to my letter of the 28th April last respecting the steamer "RIPLEY CASTLE" I beg to acquaint you that I am in receipt of a communication from the Society's Surveyors at Southampton in which they state that this vessel is still laid up at that port, and I have to say that, in the circumstances, the Committee have deferred consideration of the case for the present subject to the Boiler Survey being carried out before she is again placed in commission.

The Committee are also agreeable to the survey of the port screwshaft, which became due at the end of July last, being postponed for the present.
