Précis of particulars of Casualty

During a westerly gale on 12th January this vessel drove on Portland Breakwater and sank. She is lying on her side in 56 feet of water.

In reply to a special casualty letter the Owner states that he has abandoned the vessel to the Underwriters, and is awaiting their views. He will write again immediately he has definite information.

13th March 1930

The Cardiff Surveyors now state that there are no prospects of salvaging the vessel, and the Underwriters are settling on the basis of a total loss.

SOURCE OF INFORMATION.

THE FORESTER.—Portland, Jan. 13.—Steamer The Forester, Poole for Swansea, no cargo, weatherbound in Portland Harbour during a terrific westerly gale on Sunday evening (Jan. 12), drove on Portland Breakwater and sank. Crew got ashore on breakwater and were afterwards taken off by the Weymouth lifeboat.

Portland, Jan. 13.—Steamer The Forester, of Cardiff, sank in Portland Harbour at 8.55 p.m. on Jan. 12. Crew landed at Weymouth by lifeboat.

THE FORESTER.—Weymouth, Jan. 14.—Steamer The Forester: Nothing can be seen of the vessel, she is evidently holed and apparently lying on her side in 56 ft. of water to north of Beacon C., eastern arm of breakwater, and close up. — Lloyd's Agent per Salvage Association.
