Dear Sir,

S. With reference to Glasgow first entry reports No. 43156 on the machinery for the steamer "WHEATCROP" and No. 43157 on the steamer "WHEATPLAIN" (Hansen Shipbuilding Co's Nos. 9 and 10 S.S.), I have to acquaint you that in view of the affairs of the Hansen Shipbuilding Co. at Bideford having been placed in the hands of an Official Receiver, the Owners of these vessels were approached with a view to obtaining payment of the fees outstanding for the Special Survey of the vessels during construction.

A remittance for the amount in question has now been received from the Owners excepting as regards the amount of £7 remaining unpaid in connexion with the survey of the boilers of the "WHEATCROP" and £13-6s outstanding for the survey of the boilers of the "WHEATPLAIN".

I have therefore to request you will be good enough to obtain payment of these amounts from Messrs. W. Beardmore & Co. with a view to the classification of the two vessels being completed and certificates issued.
