In reply to your letter dated the 3rd ultimo enclosing a letter addressed to Messrs Garcia & Diaz respecting the barges "Primera", "Segunda", "Tercera" & "Cuarta", we are now informed by this firm that these lighters were sold by them to S^{ra} Maciel y Gramajo whose postal address is Ave. de Mayo 1034, Buenos Aires, & that they were brought to this port.

Upon enquiry at the Prefectura del Rio de la Plata we are now further informed that the "Cuarta" is sunk in the River Plate, & that the "Primera", "Segunda" & "Tercera" now lie in bad order & sunk in the 5th section of the New Port, Buenos Aires, where they have been abandoned.
