Nature of Survey

The class is subject to indented plating port and starboard being faired at the Owners' convenience and to ^a damaged shell plate on starboard side aft being renewed on vessel's return to a home port.

The vessel requires to be specially examined in dry dock at the first convenient opportunity on account of grounding.

The Saint John, N.B. Surveyor/^{now}reports the vessel examined afloat and on account of damage through heavy weather, repairs effected to windlass, hatchways etc.

It is submitted action be deferred.
