

With reference to your letter of the 21st instant respecting the case of the s.s. "ELMSHORN" I have to advise you that the s.s. "ELMSHORN" is included in the list of German vessels intended to be broken up in accordance with the Government breaking-up scheme. The breaking up of the vessel will, it is expected, be commenced in October of this year and in the circumstances it will not be possible to hold the screw shaft survey which became due in the case of this vessel in June, 1932.
