Sirs,

I enclose herewith the Barrow first entry reports 1830 and 1831 on four "A" type boilers made by Messrs. Kincaid & Co. Ltd., which have been purchased by Messrs. J. G. Kincaid & Co. of your port and forwarded to their works. The Society's Surveyors at Barrow, in forwarding these reports, state that Messrs. Kincaid & Co., may not fit them on board in the pairs reported, and they have consequently only inserted the approximate numbers in pencil on the reports. It is understood that two of the boilers will be allocated to Messrs. The Glasgow Shipbuilding & Drydock Co's No. 314 vessel.

As soon as it is known which boilers will be fitted on board this vessel you will be good enough to forward a report on to the Glasgow Office for the information and guidance of the Surveyors in completing the survey.

I think it well to add that the approved plan of the boilers in question has been forwarded to the Society's Surveyors at Belfast, together with the Barrow first entry report 1829 on two similar boilers, which are being fitted into Messrs. The North of Ireland Shipbuilding Co's No. 90 vessel.
