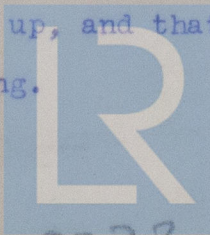
Dear Sir,

The Society's Middlesbrough Office have, however, made enquiries at our request and are informed that the vessel is now in the hands of The South Stockton Shipbreaking Co. for breaking up, and that she arrived safely in the Tees this morning.

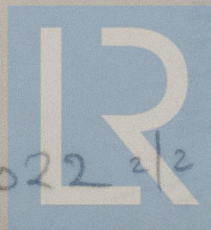

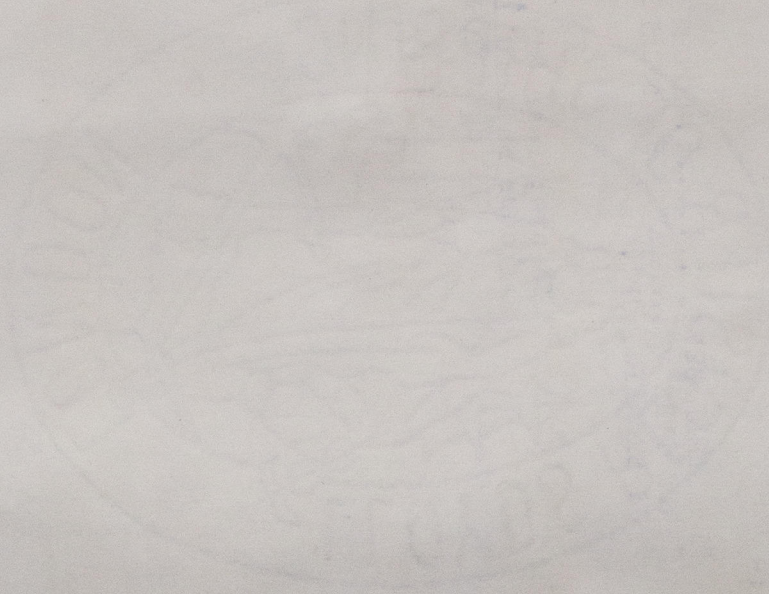
