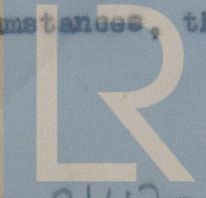

Dear Sirs,

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 22nd instant respecting the fees charged in connexion with the Special Survey during construction of the steamer "CITY OF CAMBRIDGE", recently built by your goodselves for the City Line, Ltd., and in reply, have to say that your remarks have been carefully considered.

The Committee believe you will see, however, that it would be impracticable to differentiate in the matter of fees, as suggested in your letter, according to the length of time for which a vessel had already been under survey when the revision of fees came into force.

The Committee of this Society deferred making any change in the charges for surveys held by the Surveyors until the matter became imperative, owing to the serious increase in the Society's expenses of all kinds, and even then, the Committee gave six months notice of the intended alterations, and in the circumstances, they regret that they

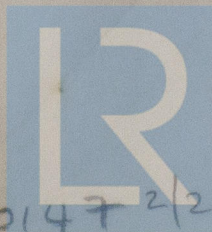
are unable to meet your wishes as to a modification being
